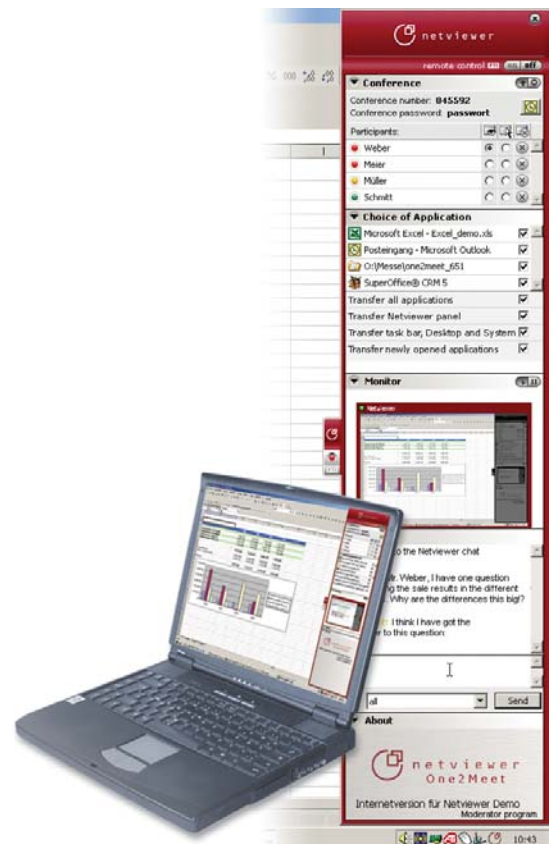
The future: Online Meetings with Netviewer one2meet

Netviewer one2meet is the most amazingly simple way of communicating over distance. Just a few clicks of the mouse is all it takes to initiate or participate in an online meeting and to interactively work together on documents **-without prior installation or registration.**

The intuitive software and easy operation will soon make Netviewer meetings as familiar at the workplace as e-mail and telephone.

Whether planned long-term or spontaneously, whether it spans distances or departments, the principle of the meeting is the same:

The participants meet up for a telephone conference in a virtual conference room. Now they can show each other their screen content - live - to discuss and edit the documents on display.

The control centre for your communications: The Netviewer control panel

Unique user interface

The Netviewer control panel contains all of the functions that ensure an uncomplicated course of events at an online meeting: A list of participants with simple means to grant remote control rights and for changing the direction of view, chat, choice of applications, and back monitor.

Invitation function with connection to Outlook

With the connection to Outlook, any number of meetings can be planned and directly transferred to Outlook. If desired, the participants can then be directly invited to the relevant meetings via email.

Transfer screen/remote control

A single mouse click is all it takes for the moderator to allow individual participants to display the content of their own screen or to receive remote control over the screen currently being displayed.

Choice of applications

The checkboxes allow the operator of the screen currently being displayed to choose which applications are to be visible to the group and which ones are not.

Netviewer clip

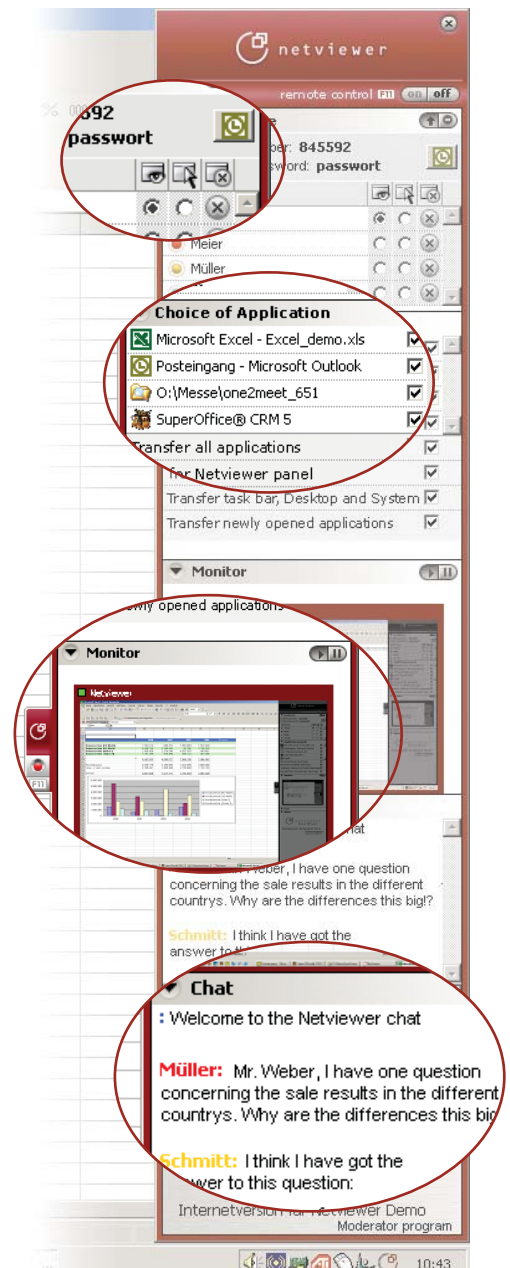
If the Netviewer control panel is not required, a mouse click is all it takes to make it disappear off the right-hand edge of the screen behind the clip - and it can be recalled in just the same way. This is one way to ensure that nothing detracts from the display of the screen during a presentation.

Back monitor

The back monitor allows the moderator to check the content of the screen being displayed to the other users, i.e. whether the content is being displayed in the right size of window.

Chat

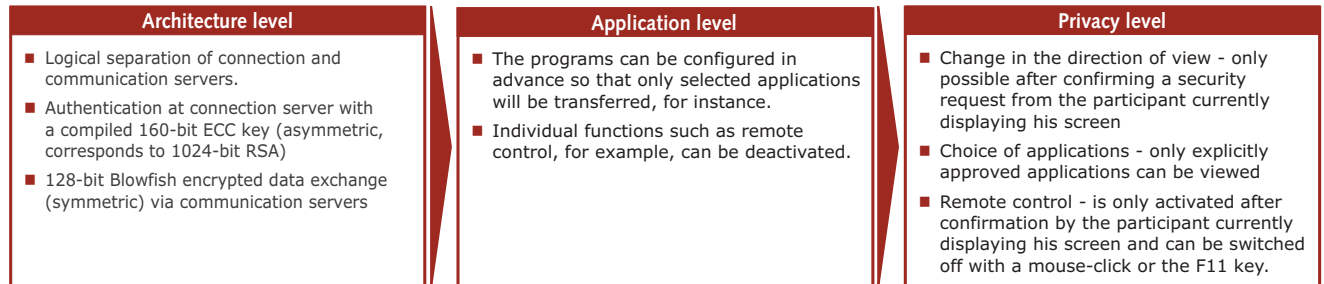
This is for non-verbal communication during the meeting; participants have the option to ask questions or to make comments without actually disturbing the moderator during a presentation.



Security

Maximum security is assured by a 3-stage concept. This satisfies all security criteria at the levels of architecture and application, and also regarding privacy.

Standard functions at a glance

Planung with Outlook

The connection with Outlook enables appointments to be coordinated in ease, entered into your calendar, and for invitations to be sent to the intended participants via email.

Pointer

If a participant wishes to draw the moderator's attention to something on screen, he just has to click on the area in question. The spot is then marked for 3 seconds by a blinking arrow with the participants name.

Choice of applications

A user with his screen content on display can hide specific applications from view during a web conference. For example, this allows the moderator to view and work on documents that are not intended for viewing by the other participants.

Pass on display rights

The Moderator can allow any participant to display his own screen content to the other conference participants.

Switching remote control on/off

The moderator can grant remote control rights to other participants so that they can directly work on displayed documents, i.e. the participants can operate approved applications from remote locations. A press on the F11 key at any time causes these remote control rights to be revoked immediately.

Chat

Participants can ask questions during a presentation without directly disturbing the moderator during his presentation.

Back monitor

The back monitor allows the user with his screen on display to see how his screen appears to the other participants.

If required, individual functions can also be deactivated.

Technical details

- Runs on all Windows platforms as of WIN95
- Requirements: PC with Internet access and any browser (also via proxy)
- No installation, configuration or registration necessary
- Temporarily download a single EXE file of ca. 300 kB
- Firewall compatible (HTTP tunnelling via port 80)
- No technical restrictions from low bandwidth (e.g. when using a modem)
- PC remains unchanged (no system changes from DLLs or registry entries, etc.)
